1 Champagne pleasures Hockenheim Germany

May 6/7, 2017
Mike Rockenfeller manages a good start to the season in his Schaeffler Audi RS 5 DTM, clinching a third and a seventh place in the opening races.



2 Strong early form Lausitzring Germany

May 20/21, 2017
With two impressive comebacks from grid positions eight and eleven to fifth-place finishes, Rocky continues attracting attention in the DTM.



Rate: 100 % Budapest Hungary

June 17/18, 2017
Six races, six point results: Mike Rockenfeller has established his spot in the top group of the standings following a fourth and tenth place at the Hungaroring.



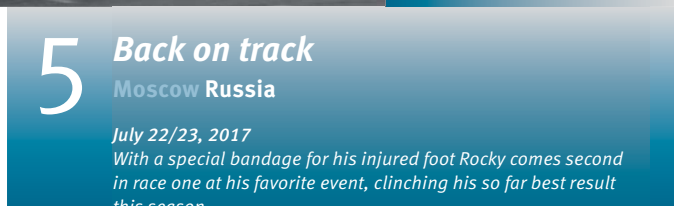
4 Shock moment Nürburgring Germany

Victory and fourth place: Mike Rockenfeller in the Netherlands scored as many points as no other race driver – position three in the standings.

With a special bandage for his injured foot Rocky comes second in race one at his favorite event, clinching his so far best result this season.

Setback Nürburgring Germany

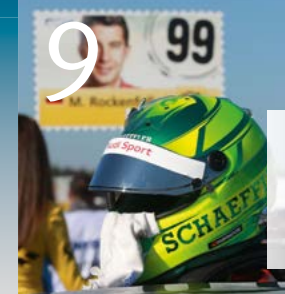
September 9/10, 2017
